



#### **EVENT SUGGESTIONS**

- Set out snacks for the kids. Santa recommends milk and cookies. But maybe just milk for Santa Baby . . .
- Encourage kids to come in their best Santa hats and reindeer ears!
- Hide a star or snowflake cutout somewhere in the room. Whoever finds it gets to read the part of Santa Baby!
- Make copies of the activities in this booklet and provide markers, crayons, and safety scissors.

#### **READ-ALOUD TIPS**

- Use a serious voice for the narrator. Ask one person to read the part of Santa Baby to maximize comic effect.
- Ask the kids about their favorite holiday memories. What is their favorite tradition?
- It seems like everything is going wrong this holiday season for Santa's elves! Ask your storytime group about a time they had to work together to fix a problem.



Look at the two pictures below. Can you find the differences? (Hint: There are four!)







The elves need your help finding the real Santa! Follow the maze to help them track down the current Santa.














