MATERIALS:

Square sheets of light pink tissue paper Square sheets of dark pink tissue paper Square sheets of green tissue paper Green pipe cleaner



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Collect all of your materials.
- 2. Layer all the sheets of tissue paper on top of each other, light pink on top and green on bottom.
- 3. Make accordion folds every inch until you're left with a stack of folds.
- 4. Take the green pipe cleaner and loop it around the middle of the stack. Twist the pipe cleaner back around itself, locking it into place.
- 5. Hold your paper and pipe cleaner up so that the stem points down and the pink is on top.
- 6. Set the flower down and pull one sheet of paper up at a time, alternating left and right.
- 7. Continue until the papers have been pulled up and out.
- 8. Here is your lotus flower!






